

EXCURSION RULES

The excursion rules listed below will be verbally explained to the students on arrival at the Park. It is requested that **ALL** students remain on the bus until rules have been explained by one of the Park staff.

However, it is requested that you also go through each of the rules with the students **PRIOR** to the excursion.

Adequate adult/student ratios must be adhered to. The Australian Reptile Park requires 1:5 for kindergarten students and 1:10 for years 2 – 6. The teachers/parents within the ratio are FOC with the excursion group and any other attending adults are required to pay \$18.00 either through the school prior to the excursion or upon entry to the Park with the school. Students **MUST** be supervised at all times.

ALL STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE TO THEIR TEACHER A COMPLETED PERMISSION NOTE SIGNED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. THE ONUS WILL BE PLACED ON THE SCHOOL TO ENSURE THIS REQUIREMENT HAS BEEN MET. A TEMPLATE FOR USE CAN BE FOUND ON THE RESOURCES PAGE.

FOR THE INFORMATION OF THE STUDENTS:

1. All students must be mindful of dropping rubbish and ensure that they use the bins at the Park. This is to ensure that the free roaming animals do not pick something up that could possibly make them very sick. Rubbish bins are provided throughout the Park.
2. Students **MUST NOT** tap on windows or glass while in Lost World of Reptiles or Spider World. It is also requested that noise be kept to a minimum.
3. Students are requested not to chase any free roaming animals, pull their tails or generally harass or distress the animals.
4. **DO NOT REACH OVER ANY FENCES, GLASS OR WALLS.**
5. Students must at all times abide by Park rules and listen to their teachers/group leaders and any Reptile Park staff member.
